They provide help with rent and utilities along with being diligent in making sure that they are not receiving payments from multiple sources which exceed the need. She shared with us that their request for food is up 84% from last year. One of the very helpful sources of support is Angels Attic. The food pantry provides food and toiletries to individuals and families, averaging over 150 tons per year. They also provide other services such as Operation Jobs which assist in resume preparation, mock interviews & provide job leads. They also have a resale shop and the proceeds help fund all administrative expenses for CAM. Your donations are distributed through our programs directly to the clients.

Cypress Assistance Ministries also has a program called "Second Chances" which help individuals with a criminal record obtain employment. They have succeeded in 20% of these people having had success in securing employment. These figures seem low but they are only including the people that have reported their success back to CAM.
